Management is responsible for the accompanying combined special-purpose regulatory basis financial statements of the governmental activities, the aggregate discretely presented component units, each major fund, and the aggregate remaining fund information of the Federated States of Micronesia (FSM) National Government and the States of the FSM as of and for the year ended September 30, 2022, in accordance with the regulatory basis of accounting, and for determining that the regulatory basis of accounting is an acceptable financial reporting framework. We have performed compilation engagement in accordance with Statements on Standards for Accounting and Review Services promulgated by the Accounting and Review Services Committee of the AICPA. We did not audit or review the financial statements nor were we required to perform any procedures to verify the accuracy or completeness of the information provided by management. We do not express an opinion, a conclusion, nor provide any assurance on these financial statements.

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with the regulatory basis of accounting, which is a basis of accounting other than accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. The combined special-purpose financial statements include the accounts of the FSM National Government and the four States of the FSM, being the State of Chuuk, the State of Kosrae, the State of Pohnpei and the State of Yap. These entities comprise the sovereign nation of the FSM. The combined special-purpose financial statements were prepared for the purpose of complying with the reporting requirements of the United States Department of Interior.

The accompanying combining schedules shown on pages 18 through 25 is presented for purposes of additional analysis and is not a required part of the basic financial statements. Such information is the responsibility of management. The supplementary information was subject to our compilation engagement. We have not audited or reviewed the supplementary information and do not express an opinion, a conclusion, nor provide any assurance on such information.

Management has elected to omit substantially all the disclosures ordinarily included in financial statements prepared in accordance with the regulatory basis of accounting. If the omitted disclosures were included in the financial statements, they might influence the user's conclusions about the combined financial position and combined results of operations of the FSM National Government and the States of the FSM. Accordingly, the financial statements are not designed for those who are not informed about such matters.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the FSM and the United States Department of Interior and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than these specified parties.

Financial Reporting Framework

The FSM National Government and the FSM state governments are separate entities. Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States do not allow for the presentation of combined financial statements for entities with no common ownership. However, the United States Department of Interior (USDOI) requires preparation of combined financial statements and, accordingly, the combined special-purpose financial statements have been prepared under a regulatory basis of accounting for the purposes of the USDOI.

Eliminations

Compact sector grants assistance funds totaling \$74,162,860 provided by USDOI to the FSM National Government and which are passed down to the FSM state governments are (1) recorded as revenues and (2) expenditures by the FSM National Government.

The FSM state government also records receipt of compact sector grants as revenues when passed down to them. The compact sector grants are a source of funding for expenditures incurred by the FSM state governments.

To avoid overstatement, \$74,162,860 of compact revenues and \$74,192,860 of expenditures, has been eliminated in preparation of the combined special-purpose financial statements.
