

ONPA Staff's Christmas Dinner at Club Cupid's

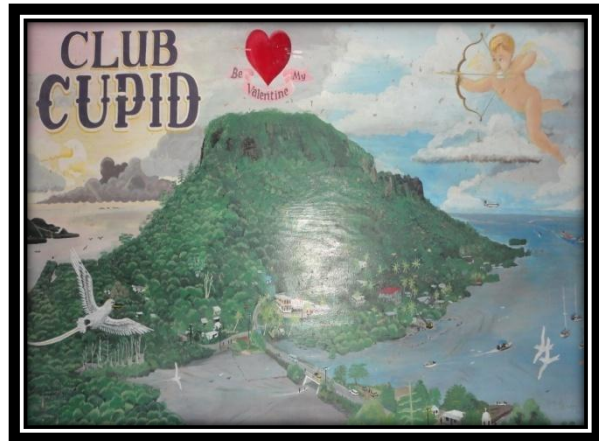
